

μBone – Clinician Scientist Position

- Goal:** Encourage active participation of clinician-scientists with clinical expertise in the areas of hematology/oncology, pathology, gynecology, urology, endocrinology/bone diseases, orthopedics, radiology, and nuclear medicine to strengthen translational aspects and to validate key findings obtained from animal models in human cells and tissues.
- Eligibility:**
- Applicants must be within 5 years after completing their MD degree
 - Applicants must be affiliated with one of the current μBone PI's
 - Aim of the research grant must be in line with the μBone research aims (i.e. exploring novel mechanisms of breast and prostate cancer cell colonization into the bone, defining interactions of circulating and disseminated tumor cells with the bone microenvironment or developing and validating novel tools for bone metastases research)
- Funding:** Personnel costs (full-time) for up to 12 months (according to DFG Personnel Rates 2022; Ä 1 Level 2 to Ä 2 Level 1); part-time also possible (50% for 2 years)
- Requested documents:** Detailed project description (max. 1 page)
